## DIRECTIONS TO CAMELOT BY THE SEA

### From North

Take Hwy US-501 into Myrtle Beach.  
Turn LEFT (North) onto Highway US-17 Business / N Kings Hwy.  
Turn RIGHT onto 21st Ave. N.  
Turn RIGHT onto North Ocean Blvd.  
Registration is on the LEFT inside covered driveway.

### From South

Take Hwy US-17 Business North into Myrtle Beach.  
Turn RIGHT onto 21st Ave. N.  
Turn RIGHT onto North Ocean Blvd.  
Registration is on the LEFT inside covered driveway.

### From Myrtle Beach International Airport

From airport parking lot take first RIGHT onto Harrelson Blvd.  
Turn LEFT onto Highway US-17 Business / S Kings Hwy.  
Turn RIGHT onto 21st Ave. N.  
Turn RIGHT onto North Ocean Blvd.  
Registration is on the LEFT inside covered driveway.

## Taxi services

Uber and Lyft are popular in Myrtle Beach. Please allow a little extra time than usual (up to 15 minutes). Average cost of these services from MYR to Camelot is between \$10-\$15.

Check-in time: **3pm**

Check-out time: **11am**

If you need late check-out please email us. Often we can accommodate this, However, our cleaning team must come in at 12pm to deep clean per Covid-19 regulations, etc. Also, the keypad lock is set to expire 45 minutes after checkout.

Our condo is privately owned, which means you do not need to check in at the front desk. You may proceed straight up to the condo. Although Camelot is also a hotel the front of desk staff are

not supposed to assist guests of owners. Often they do anyway, and if you show up at the lobby and don't tell them which room you are in they will likely assist you. But things like provisions and towels etc, must go through us (more info on that below).

If driving, you can park your car in the building's own lot, which has 9 floors of parking (floors 2-10). There will always be spaces available during the off season. In the summer months it gets much busier but there should still be plenty of spaces. If there is anything you need please let us know.

### **Parking instructions**

The lobby staff are obliged to give you an official **parking pass**. If there are ever any issues with this please contact us immediately. In the meantime, we will email you a parking pass that we have used in the past, but it's best to get an official one from Camelot. I will email you a temporary pass, and there should be extras in the welcome binder in the living room. There is a height restriction in the parking lot, but we recently saw an Escalade and a large truck in the lot, so if you have a regular car, you'll be fine. You must fill out your license number and display this in the car whenever parked at Camelot. Parking is free and is limited to one vehicle per condo. You may park another car in the lot at your own risk of getting it towed. They don't really check the cars too often, so if you had two cars you might get away with it. When you arrive you may drive straight up to the parking lot. There is 10-minute parking on the ground level by the lobby in case you want to pick up the official



parking pass first. The code for the security gate is **#1014**. See image of the keypad to the parking lot (right). You do not need to enter the code to leave the parking facility.

### **Entry to the apartment**

You will receive the lock code and a video of it in action 2 days before your stay. We have recently installed a Schlage Grade 1 security lock with a keypad. There are just two functions to open and two to close, as follows:

#### **To open the door:**

1. Enter the 4-digit code, sent to you separately.
2. Turn the lock (directly under the keypad) clockwise to unlock the door then use the lower handle to open the door.

#### **Locking from the inside:**

Simply turn the lock clockwise until the lock is activated. Please note that the door does not lock automatically so when you are in the apartment you may want to lock the door.

#### **Locking when leaving the condo:**

1. After closing the door press the Schlage button at the top of the keypad once.
2. Turn the lock counter-clockwise and wait 5 seconds until the green light goes off. You'll know if the door is locked because the lock mechanism can be rotated freely in either direction.

### **Owner's closet**

The living room closet is locked with a deadbolt and internal Blink security device to protect our personal items. It goes without saying, please don't try to break in (attempts have been made!)

### **Packing suggestions**

We have many items for you in our condo, most of which are in the kitchen. A full inventory is listed lower down. We suggest you bring the following with you since they are not offered by us, nor by Camelot:

- Beach towels
- Umbrella
- Beach chairs
- Phone and other chargers
- Toothpaste
- Binoculars – if you own them you should bring them. Not only have the sunsets been mind-blowingly gorgeous of late, there is an abundance of wildlife, in particular magnificent sea ospreys who fly close to the building when hunting for fish.
- Quarters, for laundry (\$10 X 25c = \$2.50; \$1.50 for washing; \$1.00 for drying).

There is a Dollar General two blocks away in case you forget toiletries, etc. More on that later.


## House Rules!

*Many of these are 'no-brainers', but we must cover ourselves!*


- Please do not smoke in the condo or on the balcony. An additional deep cleaning fee will be charged to eliminate the odor of smoke.
- Please do not lose or take the remote controls for the two TVs or 2 DVD players. Loss will incur a \$150 fee per remote control because the TVs cannot be used without a remote.
- Please do not take the batteries from the remote controls.
- No loud parties or gatherings after 10pm.
- **Please do not place hot pans, etc, or anything that stains onto the quartz countertops.**
- **Please wipe away stains quickly and use the 2 trivets (located in the bottom right-hand drawer) to place hot items upon. Red wine will stain the quartz, as will, for example, the ink from a pizza box logo, etc.**

## Special instructions for a couple of items:

TV – the TV in the living room takes a little while to connect to the WiFi (1509-5G). When you turn it on you may encounter a notification that says it cannot connect to the server. This is the screen you will see:




Please try hitting the OK button (on Start streaming) several times and it should eventually connect. You'll likely get this screen a lot to start with:



You may keep going round in circles hitting OK a few times. If you still have not connected we have found that hitting the Netflix button on the remote control seems to prompt the antenna to connect. Once you are past that (annoying) home screen hit the 'Home' button on the remote and you can navigate to many features this TV has to offer.

For cable TV there will be an icon on the right of the screen that is called Live TV. See the screenshot you will see, below:



From there you can scroll up and down to watch hundreds of channels. [A list of channels can be found in at the end of this document.](#) The channel list found in the welcome binder may be out of date since this list of channels was released to us on November 1st, 2020.

There are more channels as well. If you scroll as far as 96.1 you'll get all the music channels like classical, jazz, country, 80s, etc. You can set up the Guest TV so that it will check out when you leave so that if you logged into Netflix, etc, it will delete all of your information from this TV when you leave.

### **DVD player**

The DVD player can be found by going hitting HOME then scrolling right to HDMI 1.

The HDMI 2 port (yellow cable) is open and for your own personal device. (There's a third HDMI port as well.)

### **RENTAL INSTRUCTIONS**

We are not going to list everything here of course, but here are a few suggestions that may help you when staying at Ocean's Melody...

### **Coffee machine**

We recently purchased a lovely **Keurig** coffee machine. To use it, simply fill up the rear water tank, press the ON button, and insert the pod by lifting the front portion. Then, push the size coffee you want to brew (8oz, 10oz, 12oz) and, finally, push the large 'K' button. It's a pretty quick machine. Your coffee should take less than a minute to brew. The cups in the cabinet are either 8oz or 10oz.

## **Toaster**

Our smoke alarms are **very** sensitive to the heat coming from the toaster. Please, when using the toaster, use the A/C outlet next to the Keurig and turn on the oven fan while toasting. The fan button is located on the microwave's keypad and is the lowest right button. Set it to medium to extract the heat. We'd hate for the smoke alarm to go off since it's pretty loud. To cancel the toaster turn the dial counter clockwise till the bread pops up!

## **Oven**

When cooking please note that, as above, the heat from the rings and especially from opening the door when the oven is hot may trigger the smoke alarm. To prevent this, please use the fan when cooking to extract the heat. Note that there may be pots and pans stored in the oven so please check this before turning on the oven.

## **Wi-Fi network and password**

The WiFi is free and open. You can jump on any network you see. Ours are 1509 and 1509-5G. The router gives off the best signal in the living room but should give you decent enough service in the bedroom.

## **Trash removal**

There is a trash bin located by each elevator bank. You may discard any trash there. We are recyclers but Camelot is not. If you do wish to recycle you will find green recycling bins on the beach.

## **MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS**

- Dust pan and broom (are located in the HVAC closet in the kitchen)
- Folding table for those romantic 'al fresco' dinners (is located in the HVAC closet in the kitchen)
- 3 X Washing machines (\$1.50 per load) and 4 dryers (\$1.00 per load) are located by the north elevator banks on the first floor. You must pay in quarters. There is a change machine opposite the dryers.
- Ice machines – there are two on the ground floor, one each by the doors leading to the elevator banks.
- Laundry detergent and fabric softener etc can be purchased from the vending machine adjacent to the dryers.
- Air conditioning is by the door from the kitchen into the living room. If you have the balcony door open turn off the AC because it won't work and you'll start to get lots of condensation.
- Hair dryer under the sink in black bag
- Full length mirror
- First aid kit is located in the lobby on the ground floor
- Outdoor safety lighting is provided after sunset
- Carbon monoxide and natural gas detectors are installed with new batteries and are tested frequently. There are three in this condo.
- Bedroom closet contains luggage rack, iron and ironing board.

## LOCAL SUGGESTIONS

### Bars and restaurants

There are so many places to choose from. Our go-to places areas follows: **Bummz Beach Café** right next door; **Strong Waters** across the street (next to the Starbucks) offers incredible cocktails and great wine. Their dinners are a little pricey but worth it, though the portions aren't very big. **River City Café** offers a truly incredible burger and top notch \$4 happy hour margaritas! Our favorite place is the **Sea Captain's House**. It's about a 10-15 minute walk north up the beach, and is located adjacent to the very blue Caribbean Resort. It's a lovely stroll to the restaurant and even nicer being able to stroll back on the beach and wade in the ocean after what we're sure will be a memorable dinner. And **SoHo Steak House** is our go to for takeout food. Their stir-fried pad Thai and stir-fried chicken Ramen are exquisite. Their salads are the freshest in town and you absolutely must try their homemade ginger vinaigrette.

### Coffee shops

There is a **Dunkin' Donuts** at Camelot, located at the south entrance to the building on Ocean Blvd. Opposite, there is a **Starbucks**.

### Grocery stores

We use several. For quick shops we go to the **Piggly Wiggly** on North Kings Highway, just two blocks south and two inland. About a 5 minute walk. There is also a **Dollar General** just two blocks inland on N. Kings H'way. This has essentials like bread and milk and canned food, pasta, snacks, beer, etc. For bigger shops we often walk to the **Walmart Local**, which is about a 35-minute walk or 5 minutes in an Uber. It is located at 39-15 N. Kings H'way. It has most things you'll likely need. There are several **Super Walmarts** and a **Publix** about a 10-minute drive away. For liquor, we use Mona's, which seems to have everything. Again, a long walk. If you want something more local there's a liquor store next to the **Dollar General**.

### Shopping areas

Best to 'Google' these. There are numerous shops in Myrtle Beach, lots of fun shops at Broadway at the Beach, and a huge outlet mall all fairly close to Camelot.

### Nearby parks or popular outdoor areas

The beaches are all public. We like to take long walks on the boardwalk going south. Equally, you can walk about 1-2 miles north along the beach and take in the beautiful sunsets and the glorious mansions on the seafront between here and North Myrtle Beach.

### Gyms, Movie Theaters

Again, there are several and you'll have to Google them to see if they are open, etc.

### Museums or national monuments

Ripley's Believe it or Not, The Aquarium, and many others are here. Googling would be best for what you are into.

### Urgent care centers

Our **VRBO** page lists all the doctors, police, fire and medical institutions and their numbers. There's nowhere to fill out this information on Airbnb. The front desk also has this information.

## Places of Worship

Several Methodist Churches and other places of worship are right here in Myrtle Beach.

## DEPARTURE – what to remember:

- Check out: **11:00 am**
- The entry code to your door will work until 11:45am to give you chance to come back in case you have forgotten anything. Otherwise, the cleaners will enter around the same time to change the code and to clean the apartment and check inventory and to look for damages, etc.
- Close and lock the balcony door
- Make sure you didn't leave anything on the balcony, in the closets or in the drawers
- Please turn off all lights
- Please place all garbage into the outside containers by the elevators
- Please empty the fridge and freezer of any food
- Please strip bed linens and leave on laundry/towels on the floor
- Please turn off AC/heater
- Please make sure the oven is turned off


